

Letter of Recommendation

To whom it may concern

This letter serves to confirm that Trudy Rilling-Collins has been working as a pest control expert in the Four Seasons resort at Kuda Huraa, Maldives, for four consecutive weeks between April 14th and May 11th 2012.

The Marine Discovery Centre (MDC) located at the Four Seasons resort at Kuda Huraa, Maldives, is part of a collaboration between Seamarc Pvt. Ltd., a company providing environmental expertise and conducting diverse marine life conservation programs in the Maldives, and the Four Seasons resorts, Maldives.

This is why she spent a lot of time talking to the local community and to the resort employees, ensuring everybody understands the importance of her program.

Compared to the classic chemical pest control system, Trudy's methods are far more efficient in controlling the mosquito and other pests' populations, obviously much more environmental friendly and finally much more cost efficient.
